

ABSTRAK

Judul Skripsi : Hubungan Penerapan Protokol Kesehatan Sebelum dan Sesudah Vaksinasi Covid-19 Pada Mahasiswa Fakultas Kedokteran Universitas Yarsi Angkatan 2019 Tinjauannya Menurut Agama Islam.

Latar belakang: *Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus 2 (SARS-COV-2)* merupakan penyebab dari *Corona Virus Disease-19 (Covid-19)* yang ditetapkan oleh *World Health Organisation WHO* sebagai pandemi. Dalam Islam, wabah telah terjadi pada zaman Nabi Muhammad SAW dengan diperintahkan untuk menghindari penyebarannya. Penyebaran Covid-19 dapat diminimalisir dengan melakukan protokol kesehatan termasuk melakukan vaksinasi. Vaksinasi memiliki manfaat untuk mengurangi risiko tertularanya Covid-19 sehingga dapat membentuk persepsi pada masyarakat dan mulai tidak patuh pada protokol kesehatan. Penelitian ini dilakukan pada Mahasiswa Fakultas Kedokteran Universitas YARSI angkatan 2019 dengan tujuan untuk menilai apakah terdapat hubungan antara vaksinasi dengan perubahan disiplin protokol kesehatan.

Metode: Jenis penelitian berupa survei analitik dengan rancangan penelitian *cross sectional*. Kuesioner didistribusikan dengan *google form*. Penelitian ini dilakukan kepada Mahasiswa Fakultas Kedokteran Universitas YARSI angkatan 2019 sebanyak 171 responden. Analisis yang dilakukan adalah univariate serta bivariate dengan menggunakan *pearson correlation*.

Hasil: Berdasarkan hasil uji statistik terdapat hubungan antara vaksinasi dengan perubahan protokol kesehatan pada responden. Pada penelitian ini, ditemukan responden lebih patuh setelah dilakukannya vaksinasi.

Kesimpulan: Terdapat hubungan antara dilakukannya vaksinasi dengan perubahan dalam kepatuhan berprotokol kesehatan.

ABSTRACT

Title : The Relationship Between the Implementation of Health Protocols Before and After Covid-19 Vaccination in Students of The Faculty of Medicine, YARSI University Class of 2019 and the review in Islam

Background: Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus 2 (SARS-COV-2) is the cause of Corona Virus Disease-19 (Covid-19) which was designated by the World Health Organisation WHO as a pandemic. In Islam, the occurrence of a plague has occurred in the time of the Prophet Muhammad SAW by being ordered to avoid its spread. The spread of Covid-19 can be minimized by carrying out health protocols including vaccinations. Vaccination has benefits to reduce the risk of contracting Covid-19 so that it can form perceptions in the community and begin to not comply with health protocols. This research was conducted on students of the Faculty of Medicine, YARSI University class of 2019 with the aim of assessing whether there is a relationship between vaccination and changes in health protocol discipline.

Method: Type of research in the form of an analytical survey with a cross-sectional research design. Questionnaires are distributed with google forms. This research was conducted on students of the Faculty of Medicine, YARSI University class of 2019 as many as 171 respondents. The analysis carried out is univariate and bivariate using pearson correlation.

Results: Based on the results of statistical tests, there is a relationship between vaccination and changes in health protocols in respondents. In this study, it was found that respondents were more obedient after vaccination.

Conclusion: There is a relationship between vaccination and changes in health protocol compliance.
